Uttara Tantra of Maitreya Sanskrit Class 2

1. In the opening lines of the Uttara Tantra in Tibetan, the author bows down to the Buddhas and bodhisattvas. In the opening lines of the Sanskrit, it reads:

ओं नमः श्रीवज्रसत्त्वाय ।

Om namaḥ śri vajrasattvāya

Om! I bow down to the glorious Keeper of the Diamond.

2. The text then describes:

बौद्धकर्म

bauddha karma

4. The ultimate Buddha is the:

धर्मकाय

dharmakāya

The apparent Buddha is the:

रूपकाय

rūpakāya
